

Are you interested in positively working for the good of myself (a person whom you would otherwise be at odds with)?

I'm going to have difficulty coming up with the \$1600 in car rental, food, motel and air fare so I can attend jury trial.

Can you loan \$1600 to me, on condition that after trial, you can deduct that amount from whatever the jury awards me in damages? "Whoever forces you to go one mile, go with him two."
